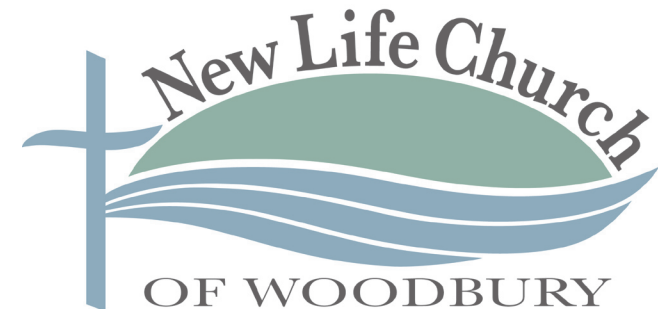
### *Seasons of Life:*
